

Tullahoma High School Student Parking Spot Painting Guidelines

Students who purchased the *Paint My Spot* option are invited to personalize their selected parking space by following the guidelines below.

General Requirements

- Students are responsible for providing all paint, brushes, rollers, tape, and any other supplies needed to complete their parking spot.
- **Only exterior/outdoor** paint may be used.
- Students are responsible for painting only their assigned parking space.
- Students are expected to clean up all materials and dispose of trash properly before leaving.

Design Guidelines

- Designs should reflect school pride, creativity, good taste, and positivity.
- Artwork should promote positive themes and be appropriate for a school setting.
- Students are encouraged to incorporate school colors, extracurricular activities, hobbies, future plans, inspirational messages, or other positive designs.
- The **white parking lines and the parking space number must remain clearly visible** and may not be painted over or altered.
- Artwork may not extend beyond the boundaries of the assigned parking space.

Prohibited Content

The following are not permitted:

- Profanity, vulgar, obscene, or suggestive language or images.
- References to alcohol, tobacco, vaping, illegal drugs, or weapons.
- Political messages, campaign slogans, or controversial social or religious statements.
- Hate speech, discriminatory language, or imagery targeting any individual or group.
- Gang symbols or inappropriate hand signs.
- Advertisements, business logos, or commercial promotions.
- Copyrighted images, logos, or artwork used without permission.
- Any image or message that school administration determines to be disruptive, offensive, or inconsistent with the educational mission of Tullahoma High School. Keep it positive. Keep it classy.

Approval and Corrections

- School administration reserves the right to require any design to be modified or removed if it does not comply with these guidelines.
- If a design is determined to be inappropriate, the student will be required to repaint the space at their own expense within the timeframe provided by the school.

- Failure to comply may result in the parking space being painted over by the school without reimbursement of the painting fee.

By choosing to “paint your spot,” students are embracing an opportunity to express individuality while contributing to a shared school environment. This program operates as a covenant between students and Tullahoma High School: students are trusted to create artwork that reflects pride, respect, and positivity, and in return, the school provides the space for that expression. Participation signifies a commitment to uphold these expectations and to honor both personal creativity and the standards of the school community.
